Each year a special theme is chosen for our community gathering Sydney Summer Spiritfest. In 2013 we will be exploring and celebrating "Passion". Passion highlights our capacity to process, withstand and overcome with dignity, grace and humour. Our passion affirms we are worthy of contentment and joy. Often we think of passion as wild and unpredictable. But passion's nature is most often cloaked in the deep, subtle, quiet and committed: nursing a baby, planting a vegie garden, preparing a special meal, caring for a loved one who is ill, persevering with a dream.

At this, our 11th Spiritfest, the programme is as wide-ranging as ever. As always, all spiritual paths are welcome. Collective meditation and kiirtan (chanting to live guitar and drums) are at the heart of Spiritfest. Don't let lack of meditation experience keep you away. We're happy to show you the basics so you can come to view your mind as a supportive friend. There are also many fun activities exploring ideas of optimism, creativity and sustainability. The central values of connectedness, empathy and responsibility shift our gaze inwards.

In this nonprofit event we co-create a communal village. It works because we use good sense and cooperative effort. Community guidelines have evolved to help things run safely and with respect. To keep costs low, we're rostered for a few tasks, mostly kitchen related.

This is a wonderful gathering to share with your kids. We provide an engaging children and young people's festival with an exciting outdoor adventure programme, which includes a 110 metre zip line flying fox across the valley! EDNA RYAN AWARDS 2012

On Friday 9 November, we attended the Edna Ryan Awards Presentation night. The "EDNA's" are awards for women who have made a feminist difference, i.e. whose activity advances the status of women: the battlers and the unsung heroines who show commitment and determination. Edna Ryan (1904-1997) contributed a lifetime of advocacy and action towards equal pay for women in Australia.

The Edna's have acknowledged over 150 women since they began in 1998. Georgina Abrahams joined 13 other women to receive a 2012 Edna Award. YACHT COLLECTIVE – Expressions of Interest Join our women's yacht collective "Les Yachties"

We are 5 women who own a 24 foot Triton yacht on Jervis Bay. We are looking for two new members to buy two of the 5 shares as two members are selling due to a change of interests.

The collective

We got together 3 years ago and decided to buy a yacht so we could sail on Jervis bay. Some had some sailing experience and some didn't. We spent several meetings deciding on our collective process and writing our articles of agreement. We each put in \$5,000 to purchase and we pay \$65.00 per month levy. Occasionally, if required, we put in an extra levy.

We meet every few months at one of our homes to discuss business. Our meetings are congenial and we have reached agreement easily on all matters so far. We have a selection process for membership as outlined in our articles of agreement. The current members are all lesbians. One of our aims is to introduce more women to sailing.

The yacht - "Isis"

Isis is a comfortable, safe, seaworthy yacht of the class Triton 24. She has a very comfortable cabin space for such a small boat. She has 6 berths and a nice galley. The hull is in good shape and we continue to do upkeep and improvements. She has a main sail, 2 sizes of foresail and a spinnaker. Her inboard diesel motor works well. She can be easily sailed by 2-5 crew. She is quite capable of coastal voyages, but we primarily use her for sailing in Jervis Bay. She is moored at Callala Bay.

The activities

We have a booking roster for use of the boat, so members can book her for particular dates for cruising. We also race regularly with the Jervis Bay Cruising Yacht club, which is a well run, friendly and accommodating group. Everyone works on the boat according to availability and skills. Lots of opportunity for picnics, adventure and weekend sleepouts!
