ZANGDRUM



As many of you know, we have been spending a lot of time over the past 3.5 years with babies and toddlers. We have now gathered a large collection of small percussion instruments and are offering pay-what-you-can drumming and percussion playshops for children's and community events.

Gabe Journey initiated Zangdrum in 2003, organising womyn's drumming retreats and community performances at places such as <u>The Women's Library</u> in Newtown. Our concept of "Zang" refers to the feelings of happiness and connectedness which can be experienced when drumming with a group of people.

Creative Womyn Down Under have decided to re-activate Zangdrum, and its original intention of sharing the enjoyment of drumming with others remains the same. On International Women's Day 8 March 2013, Zangdrum (consisting of the immediate Creative Womyn Down Under family Gabe, Georgina, Jai and Sofara) shared an interactive drumming performance and facilitated a drum circle playshop for the Newtown Neighbourhood Centre's IWD afternoon.
